Relevance of the research issue: Development of the process of globalization is one of the Central problems of contemporary economic science. Manifestations of globalization is extremely diverse. In modern economic activity there are many factors that suggest that the world economy has entered a new stage of its development.

On the modern stage of globalization urgent question about prospects of development of national economies. There is a kind of contradiction. On the one hand, in the context of globalization is intertwined national economies: developing economic cooperation, erased national borders, the flow of movement of goods, capital and services meet fewer barriers in their path. On the other hand, preserves the relevance of the issue of the need for individual countries to defend national economic interests, to ensure their own economic security.

The purpose of the work is identifying the patterns of globalization and the development of a mechanism to identify and overcome globalization deficits of the national economy.

Research objectives:

1. considering the development of the world economy and the background of globalization processes.
2. studying the nature, factors and the main features of globalization.
3. analyzing the direction of the development of globalization.
4. identifying globalization globalization advantages and deficits of national economies.
5. determining the methodological foundations of the analysis of tendencies of development of national economic systems in conditions of globalization.

Scientific novelty: the development of the concept of national economies based on the identification of patterns of globalization in the context of a multifactorial approach to the study of globalization from a position of allocation of four methodological grounds: the historical development of the world economy in the context of globalization, the signs of globalization, economic and political structure of the world economy in the context of globalization and of the typology of economic systems, as well as the three spheres of economic activity – foreign trade, international direct investment and operations in the international financial markets.

Summary: Globalization is a fundamentally new stage in the development of the world economy. It is about becoming a global economic world order. Unlike

the previous forms of organization of global economic relations (internationalization) in the conditions of globalization of the world economy increasingly takes the form of a single whole. Business entities are increasingly losing its economic isolation and international economic relations become internationalized. Signs of a global economic world order are identical to the conditions of conducting economic activity and approximately equal to the level of public welfare throughout the world; the complete absence of barriers to the movement of factors of production to their handling and use and the finished goods to the end consumer; a single mechanism of management of economic processes at the level of the world economy as a whole. Modern world economy is still very far from this state, therefore, economic globalization (emerging global) can be described as a long process with uncertain results. Uncertain are the duration of the process of becoming a global economic world order and the possibility of functioning of the global form of business.
