

Summary

Subject matter: Religious extremism: prevention and opposition in Kabardino-Balkar Republic.

Topicality of the research: the subject matter of the research is topical for all the states where the influence of religious extremism on the society is particularly noticeable. For the modern confessional situation in Russia characterized by the tense interrelations between different confessions and denominations, the problem of the historical interrelations between the religious associations and the state, and also their participation in the modern Russian political process acquires great scientific significance.

Tasks of the research:

- to examine the notion, essence and types of religious extremism;
- to compare the history of the origin of religious extremism in the past and in the present;
- to examine the penetration of religious extremism to the NCFD, specifically to Kabardino-Balkar republic;
- to study means of prevention of religious extremism in KBR;
