The topicality of the research lies in the fact that the fact that the active development of the legal regulation of interstate relations, both on the international scene and within the framework of intergovernmental organizations, leads to the fact that the importance of international bodies and their decisions in international law is constantly growing. And the Russian Federation is not an exception. Today the role of the international precedent is growing.

The aim of the research is to analyze the impact of the international precedent on the legal system of the Russian Federation.
