**Topical Importance:** is determined by the fact that among the literary of the writer Ramon del Valle Inclan a writer who introduced many new things in the development of the genre diversity of literary creativity, his works were the subject of research by philologists of Spain, Italy, France and Russia. **Goals:** is to describe the stylistic means used by Valle Inklan in the novel "Tyrant Banderas"
