

Summary

The topic of the graduate work: Managing and legal basis of functioning of representative powers of local governments (based on the materials of Kislovodsk Duma)

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Information about the organization-customer: Kislovodsk administration

Topicality: There is a fundamental principle that the social system of a country is weak until its local governments do not work as a substantial and adequately-governed unit. Local governments being closely connected with democratic principles of human rights, the theory of natural legal system build the centre of a modern theory of a democratic state. That is why it is strategically important to study the managing and legal basis constructing the functioning of representative powers of local governments.

The purpose: complex analysis of the managing and legal basis constructing the functioning of representative powers of local governments; detecting of theoretical and practical problems and introducing the ways for their solving.

Aims:

- To consider the mains courses for improvement of functioning of representative powers of local governments
- To analyze the foreign experience of functioning of representative powers of local government
- To study the principles of functioning of the representative powers in Kislovodsk Duma
- To suggest the main directions for improvement of functioning of representative powers of local governments
- **Theoretical and practical significance:** the findings formulated in the work concerning the principles of functioning of the representative

powers of local governments can be used in the further scientific development and elaboration of the named issue. The practical significance of the work lies in use of the work's results in daily work by public institutions that will lead to the improvement of their status.

The results of the research and recommendations:

- 1) One of the main ways of improvement of the representative powers of local governments is to solve the problem of misbalance of «people» and «power» role in realization of real right for representative democracy at the local level.
- 2) Realization of this right can be carried out by local elections and referendum
- 3) Local governments are characterized by a greater variability of democratic forms which are very flexible for being structured.
- 4) The most effective form of «people» and «power» interaction is public audition which can be introduced by people's will or by the representative initiative.
- 5) It is essential to make up individual plans (employee's (the representatives of local governments) of professional development which are to become the major element of additional professional education, to show true need in education, to bring out possible results, forms and types of training, including unsupervised work
