

## SUMMARY

**Subject of the thesis:** International Labor Migration as a Factor of Social and Economic Development of Modern Russia

**Relevance of the research issue:** due to a sharp increase in the scale of migration, which turns the migration process into a phenomenon of modern socio-political life? The complexity and multidimensionality of this phenomenon, as well as the constant development and transformation of the manifestations of migration themselves, lead to the emergence of a large number of definitions of migration in the scientific discourse, as well as terms of similar semantics and their unsystematic use, which actualizes the task of its conceptual comprehension and location in a system of related and identical Categories.

**The purpose** to identify the factors influencing international labor migration to the social and economic development of the state and assess the impact of the influx of labor migrants on the Russian economy.

**Research objectives:**

- to clarify the main forms and identify the factors that determine the current migration process;
- to consider approaches to international labor migration, to specify its functions and features;
- to assess the impact of international labor migration on the country's socio-economic development;
- to specify the role of Russia's migration policy in the formation of migration flows;
- to reveal the essence, features and contribution of international labor migration to the social and economic development of Russia;
- to establish trends in the further development of international labor migration and aspects of its impact on the country's socio-economic development in the context of global globalization.

**Scientific novelty:** is

- in a comprehensive understanding of the essence and content of the migration process as a political phenomenon, determining the key forms and factors of its influence on contemporary political processes, national and international security;

- in identifying the effects of foreign labor migration on the socio-economic development of Russia.

**Structure:** The work consists of an introduction, two chapters, including 6 paragraphs, conclusion, a bibliographic list of used literature containing 96 sources, including 30 of them in foreign languages, as well as 3 tables, 3 figures and 6 annexes. **Summary:** The formation of a global labor market is the result of the interaction of three processes: the increase in international mobility of the three main factors of production - capital, labor and information. Their interaction, which creates the economic integrity of the world, is becoming increasingly important.
