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Background study: due to the fact that to date, the Caucasus plays an important role in the political map of the world, and Georgia is one of the most active participants of the geopolitical processes in the South Caucasus. The current political elite of Georgia, and as the governing bodies and the forces in opposition, to seek to establish itself as a political leader, offering itself as a strategic ally of Western countries in the region. That is why the political processes taking place in Georgia to be, important from the point of view of their impact not only on the situation in the country, but also on the situation in the region as a whole.

It is important for Russia's presence and strengthen its position in the Caucasus to secure the southern border of the state, as well as to reduce the role of external factors having a place to be in the southern Caucasus. A characteristic feature of the processes in the region is to accelerate the political changes, the increase in the degree of uncertainty and attempt to participants of the geopolitical processes in the Caucasus and push each other to increase their sphere of influence. For the Russian region has historically had a great geopolitical importance, and she, recognizing his exceptional strategic importance, tried to have a monolithic sphere of influence in the Caucasus. But after the collapse of the Soviet Union and the emergence of new independent political entities Russians could be the guarantor of the security of countries of the South Caucasus, which prompted other actors of international politics for a more intensive policy influence in the region.

Objective: - is to develop a set of measures (in particular, the political, economic and military) to prevent emerging threats to security in the South Caucasus. An attempt to explore the current state of Russian-Georgian relations, as well as to analyze the medium and long term.

Research objectives:

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Scientific novelty of the study is determined by the urgency of the issues involved, as well as its insufficient development of the national political literature. For the first time this topic is so widely regarded. The study analyzed the influence of the factors that determine the foreign policy strategy of Georgia and Russia, given the events of the Georgian-South Ossetian conflict in 2008 and attempts to predict the strategic direction of the foreign policies of these states.

The structure of the work is subject to the tasks of research and includes: introduction, two chapters, consisting of six sections, conclusion and bibliography of references, numbering 70 sources, 10 of them in foreign languages. In the total work is 70 pages. Summary: A key state in the Caucasus is now considered Georgia, which has a specific geographical location, rich historical heritage, a high level of culture and education of the population and the authority in the West, the current Georgian leadership. Relations with Georgia are important for Russia, because they are largely influenced by all of our policies in the region.

However, growing evidence of anti-Russian Georgian leadership. This is understandable, because in the last few years, Georgia came under the protectorate of the United States of America, which since the days of the "cold war" are trying to exclude Russia from the international process.

Our analysis leads us to conclude that reality is extremely far from the image of the

conflict, which is formed in the Russian and Georgian society. Of course, the promotion includes elements of truth, but these elements together form a lie mythology, in which the citizens of Georgia and Russia perceive the situation. It is important that this mythological world are not only the masses, but many politicians of both countries, which are often simple mythology is much more profitable than a complex truth. Indeed, the interweaving of truth and falsehood makes the situation extremely confusing. It seems a vicious circle is created, the easiest exit from which is to take for granted one of the variants of the Russian or Georgian mythology. Naturally, the actions based on half-truths, only lead to a deepening of the crisis.

We believe that Moscow should avoid steps that would be turned against Russia the Georgian people. Today Russia has the authority to mobilize all possible international organizations in order to strengthen its position in the dialogue with Tbilisi.

For several centuries, Russia and Georgia supported the partnership. Total co-existence of these two states have endured many things: the quarrels and conflicts, and as a territorial association, as well as moral and spiritual, our people had become fraternal. Therefore, the alignment of the prospects of future relations require careful study and an important role in how our relationship will evolve in the future, play it, who will come to power in Tbilisi.
