

## Summary

**Subject matter:** International legal regulation of labour relations in the private international law.

**Topicality (novelty):** The entry of the Russian Federation to the International labour market and progressive use of foreign labour in our country. Currently in Russia, a significant number of illegal migrants of working age are engaged in the informal sector of the economy. For this reason, their human and labour rights are in many cases not respected.

**The aim of this work** is the definition of peculiarities of labour relations, complicated by a foreign element and the specifics of legal regulation of foreign citizens' activities working in the Russian Federation and Russian citizens working abroad.

**Objectives:**

- to consider the general provisions of labour relations in the Russian Federation;
- give a description of the of labour relations, complicated by a foreign element;
- to analyse the collision principles in the field of international labour relations;
- to consider issues regarding legal regulation of labour relations, complicated by a foreign element
- to determine the labour rights of foreign citizens in the Russian Federation and Russian citizens abroad.

**The theoretical and practical value of the research** lies in the fact that expressed of judgments are an addition to the available scientific research in this field. It is assumed that the result of the research can be used in higher education to study such subjects as international law, international private law.

**The results obtained:** The complicating of the labour relation by a foreign element may take differently, that, in turn, it leads to the presence of various types of labour relations, complicated by a foreign element. This means that not only the labour of foreigners in the Russian Federation can be considered with position of regulation of some of its aspects within framework in the private international law, but the labour Russian citizens abroad can also be regulated by the rules of Russian law.

**Recommendations.** The system of Russian legislation active in the field labour migration complicated by foreign element needed inclusion of a rules, imperatively determining the responsibilities of employers in ensuring proper working conditions harsher penalties of employers for non-performance of such a duty.
